Summer School Venue

Application Procedure

To apply for the ESCMID Summer School 2012, please register via the internet at www.escmid.org/summerschool. As part of the application we request to send a short letter explaining your professional situation and motivation for attending the Summer School and a brief CV. In addition, each participant is requested to submit a short description of an educational case or your research project for presentation and discussion during the Summer School. Applications are accepted until 21 May 2012; for late application check with the administrative secretariat. Participants will be selected by the ESCMID Education Subcommittee. Registration will be confirmed by 12 June 2012.

Case Study Preparation

Participants are requested to submit a case or their research project as part of the application for attending the 11th ESCMID Summer School. All participants will present their case or research project during the course. The case/research project should come from the professional experience of the applicant, be of practical relevance and have some educational value. The description should not exceed 2500 characters. Please check the Summer School website for detailed guidance. Some participants will be asked to participate at Pro-Contra Sessions with a given topic instead of presenting their case/research project.

CME Accreditation

The organisers of the 11th ESCMID Summer School will apply for European CME accreditation through EACCME.
